- 1. Call to order at 7:34pm

  - e. Need to keep an eye on the culverts as they are having sentiment buildup in them. May need to eventually have a crew clean them out.
  - f. Please be mindful of your mailboxes and consider reconditioning them. The paint is on file at Menards for color. Just go to the paint counter and they should be able to pull it for you. It will also be
